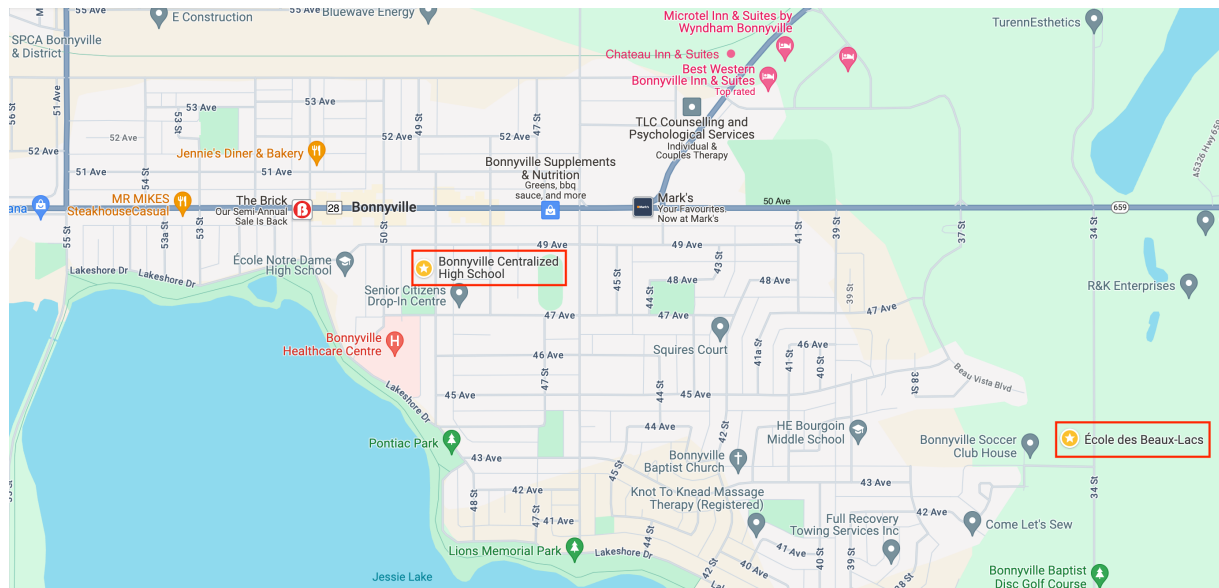

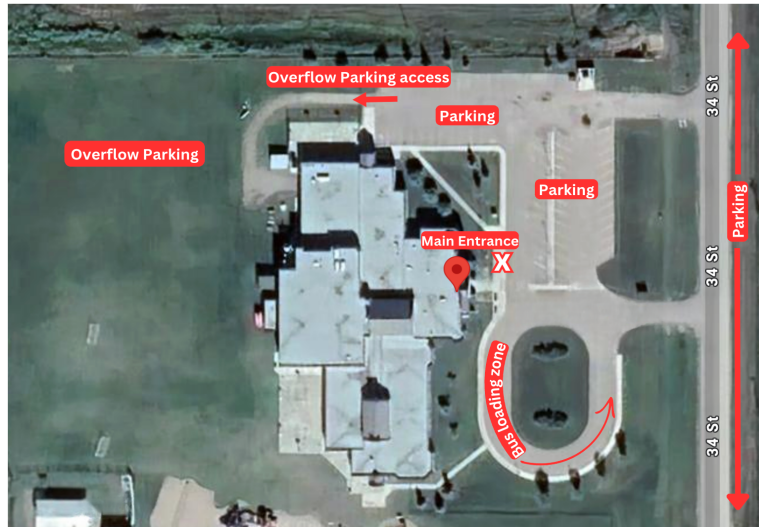
## PARKING

**École des Beaux-Lacs :**

- **Thursday**, parking will be limited as school is in session. There will be limited parking in the parking lot on the north and east sides of the building, but an overflow parking area at the back of the school will be accessible on the north side of the school. Parking on the side of the road on 34<sup>th</sup> street, east of the school is allowed. **DO NOT PARK IN THE LOADING ZONE FOR BUSES AT THE FRONT OF THE SCHOOL ON THURSDAY.** Please adhere to the reserved parking signs. Buses can park in the overflow parking.

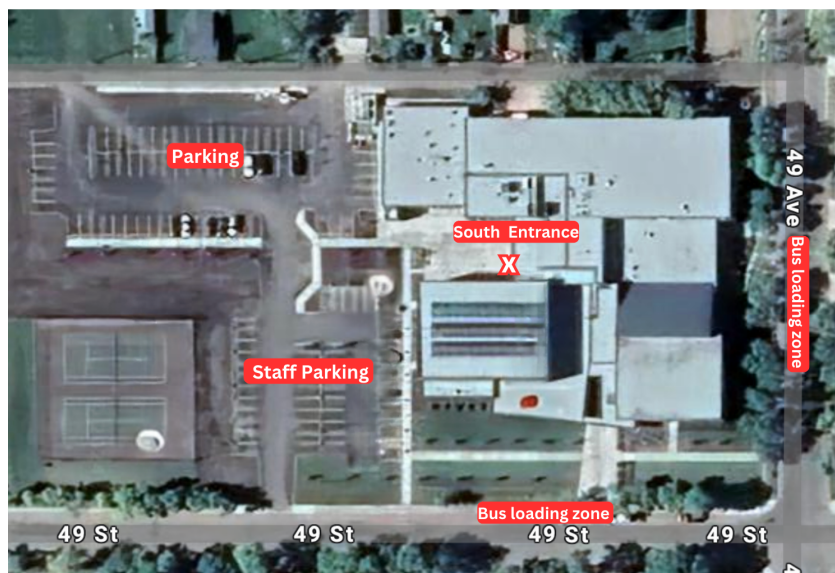


- **Friday and Saturday**, there is no school therefore parking will be available in either parking lot and along the side of the road. The loading zone for buses may also be used.
- Please use the main school entrance located on the east side of the building to gain access to the school.



#### Bonnyville Centralized High School:

- **Thursday and Friday** are regular school days at BCHS and as a result, parking will be limited. Parking is available on the north side of the school, on the streets and residential areas surrounding the school. Please adhere to the reserved parking signs. No parking in the staff parking area. **DO NOT PARK IN THE LOADING ZONE FOR BUSES AT THE FRONT OF THE SCHOOL ON 49th STREET, NOR ON THE NORTH SIDE ON 49TH AVE.**
- **Saturday**, there should be more parking available on the north side of the school on the streets and residential areas surrounding the school. The loading zone for buses at the front of the school may be used for team buses.

## **AWARDS**

### **Championship Awards**

- Champions will receive a banner, medals, a plaque, and t-shirts.
- Runner up will receive silver medals.
- Bronze medal winners will receive medals.

### **Individual Sportsmanship Award – SET THE BAR**

Teams are asked to nominate one team for the Team Sportsmanship Award before the end of the competition on Saturday. Once the committee has reviewed all the nominations and the recipient of the award has been selected, it will be submitted to the ASAA office for review.

### **FIRST AID INFORMATION AND EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN**

- Immediate first aid and athletic injuries are the responsibility of each team. Teams should have their own first aid kits.
- A certified Athletic therapist will be on site (shared between the two facilities). They will be a visual presence and available for injury management.
- Teams are responsible for bringing their own medical supplies. However, some medical supplies/ice packs will be available at the athletic therapy station.
- Limited taping supplies may be available for a fee.
- In the event of an emergency, a staff member on site will call 9-1-1. The individual will be taken to the Bonnyville Hospital.
- Refer to the Emergency Action Plan

### **GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE AND APPEAL PROCESS**

Any grievances can be brought forward to the Grievance Committee, consisting of Paul Bourgoïn, Richard Fortin, Trevor Barrington, the Head Official (or designate), and 2 neutral coaches. If a coach or athlete wishes to appeal an ejection, it is the responsibility of the Grievance/Discipline Committee to address the appeal as soon as possible, and before the next scheduled game or match. To handle the appeals of an ejection, ASAA policy states: *"All ASAA Provincial Championship Hosts will convene a Discipline/Appeal Committee. The*

*Committee will have the authority to address issues of a serious nature that may occur before, during or after a provincial championship match, or hear appeals of the automatic suspension resulting from an ejection."*
