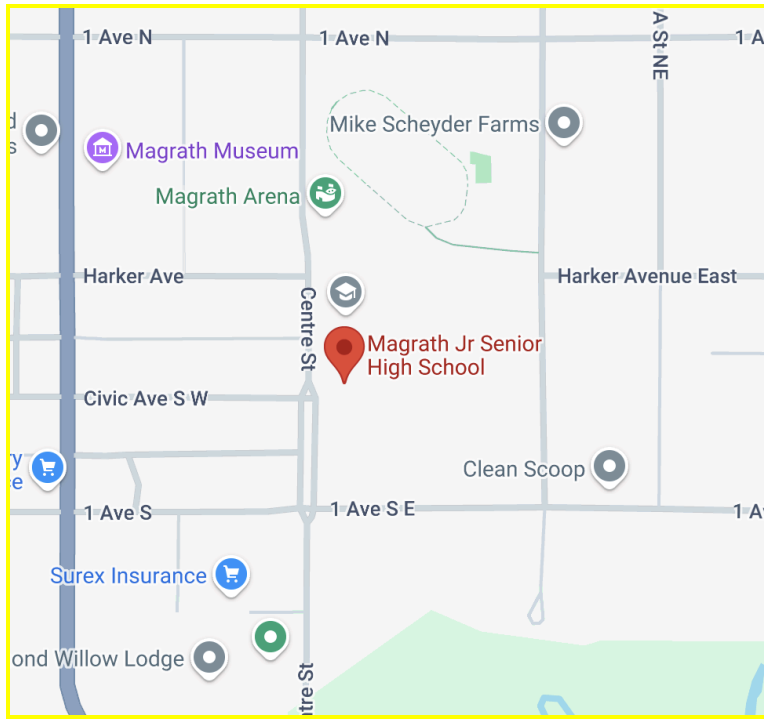

Accommodation Information

Lethbridge is a 20 minute drive from Magrath. There are many hotel choices available.

Change Rooms

Home Team will be given the male change room located at the north end of the main gym. Visiting team (lower seed) will use the female change room at the south end. Each team will also be assigned a team room for the duration of their time at the regional tournament.

Officials Room

A coaches/officials room will be provided. Food and beverages will be available throughout the regional tournament.

Concession

A full concession serving hot foot and will be available during the weekend.

First Aid

Dr. Justin Steed will be available on site for any First Aid emergencies.

Apparel

Apparel will not be sold at regional locations. Provincial apparel will be sold the following weekend at the Winsport Centre during the Final 4 weekend.

Live Streaming

Live streaming of the event will be provided on the ASAA network via the Hudl platform. Passes will be sold at \$13.49 for the weekend (no game/day passes).

Tickets

Tickets will be sold at the venue through Hudl's online ticketing system. These tickets will be \$10 for the weekend (no game/day passes).

Protests / Grievances

As per ASAA policy, a grievance committee has been organized to handle discipline and appeals. The committee will have the authority to address issues of a serious nature that may occur before, during or after a Provincial Championship match, or to hear appeals of the automatic suspension resulting from an ejection (see ASAA 2024/25 Policy Handbook). The committee may include, but not limited to, the tournament chairperson, an official and two coaches not in conflict with the issue. All grievances will be referred to the Tournament Chair who will in turn make a presentation to the Grievance Committee. The decision of this committee is final and not subject to appeal.
