Spectator Space

Spectator Space: St. Francis Xavier Main Gym has a capacity of 800 and features two sets of bleachers along the south wall, as well as additional seating on its stage, which is open for fan viewing. We kindly ask all spectators to dispose of their trash properly once the game has concluded. Additionally, to ensure smooth entry and exit, fans are requested not to stand in the doorway, as the gymnasium entrance is narrow.

Officials Room

Male and female staff changerooms attached to the gym will serve as the officials change room and meeting area.

Coaches Room

A small coach's room with light snacks and beverages will be provided for coaches, officials and volunteers in our staffroom.

First Aid

The Athletics Department at St. Francis Xavier High School is staffed by multiple members who are certified in First Aid and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) use in case of emergency. The nearest hospital, Misericordia Hospital, is located at 16940 87 Ave NW, Edmonton, AB T5R 4H5, and is approximately five minutes from the school.

Apparel

Live streaming of the event will be provided on the ASAA network via the Hudl platform. Passes will be sold at \$13.49 for the weekend (no game/day passes).

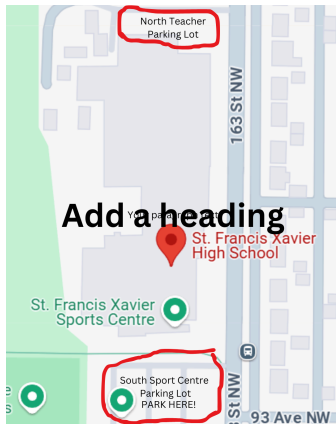
Tickets

Protests / Grievances

As per ASAA policy, a grievance committee has been organized to handle discipline and appeals. The committee will have the authority to address issues of a serious nature that may occur before, during or after a Provincial Championship match, or to hear appeals of the automatic suspension resulting from an ejection (see ASAA 2024/25 Policy Handbook). The committee may include, but not limited to, the tournament chairperson, an official and two coaches not in conflict with the issue. Coaches wishing to volunteer may do so at the coaches meeting. All grievances will be referred to the Tournament Chair who will in turn make a presentation to the Grievance Committee. The decision of this committee is final and not subject to appeal.
