**Pay it Forward Loonie Fee: \$1 per athlete according to ASAA Policy (page 44):**

"Pay it Forward Loonie Fee: Each provincial championship will charge an additional \$1 for each participating student and will remit those funds to the ASAA office after the championship. 100% of the funds will be directed into an ASAA scholarship fund to recognize student-athletes who give back to their communities by either coaching or officiating in school or community sport.

## COACHES INFORMATION

### **Coaches and Captains Meeting**

- Tuesday, May 6th, @ 7:00 pm via Zoom
- **As per the ASAA Official Handbook:** "Any team that attends provincials as the zone/regional representatives and fails to attend or send a team representative to the mandatory coaches meeting will be fined a fee of \$250 for failing to send a representative to the coaches meeting. This fee will be collected by the ASAA office and split between the host of the championship and the ASAA; the latter of which will be earmarked for the ASAA subsidy account to help offset costs to ASAA provincial hosts. The executive will have the sole discretion to waive the penalty based on the rationale provided by the school for failure to attend coach's meetings."

### **Team Photos**

- Team photos will be taken in the warmup court, Between 10am and 2pm in 15 minute intervals. Team photos will be included in the Provincial program based off photos submitted as part of your SRS registration. Players Any team that does not submit a suitable team photo by the deadline will not have a team photo in the program.

### **Team Uniforms**

- All teams must have at least one set of matching team uniforms. Goalies must wear a contrasting colour. The host venue will have pinnies available if two teams are wearing the same colour. Teams listed first on the schedule will be considered the home team and will be required to change uniforms or wear the pinnies.

### **First Aid/Athletic Therapy**

- Teams must bring their own medical supplies and plan to do their own taping. Ice will be provided. A certified athletic trainer will be on-site at Level 1 for the duration of the tournament to assist with first-aid. Any pre-existing injuries are to be dealt with by the individual, parent, medical professional or coach prior to games.

### **Equipment**

- Official Game Ball: Will be an Alberta Team Handball Federation approved HUMMEL Size 2 (boys) and Size 1 (girls)
- Practice Balls: Participating teams are required to bring their own handballs for warm-ups. Please do not use handballs in hallways or change rooms

### **Dressing Rooms**

- Each team will have their own changeroom for their slotted game. Dressing rooms will be available to teams 30m prior to the designated game start time (45m for semi-final games and medal games). Teams will be asked to exit their changeroom 30 minutes after their game so teams in following games can use these rooms. It is expected that the room will be left the way it was found. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

## **Hospitality**

- Hospitality Space: There will be a hospitality area in the North East zone. This will be available to credentialed coaches, ATHF officials, sponsor VIP's and ASAA staff
- Athletes & Coaches: There will be water refilling stations in Level 1 Sports near the front entrance

## **TEAM HANDBALL OFFICIALS INFORMATION**

### **Team Handball Officials**

- The Alberta Handball Federation is recognized to provide officials for provincial competitions. Arrangements for officials at all provincial competitions shall be made by the Executive Director and/or appointees of the ASAA Executive in cooperation with the ATHF

### **Minor Officials**

- Minor officials (scorekeepers) are volunteers.. Please treat them with respect and understanding; they are volunteering to help make the event run as smoothly as possible. Each scorekeeping table will be supervised by the tournament chair
- If you or the team has any concerns with the scorekeeping, a member of the coaching staff or teacher supervisor will address it through the Officials and/or tournament chair. Do not direct comments to the minor officials. Spectators will not address any officials/minor officials at any time, or they will be asked to leave the facility promptly.

## **OPENING CEREMONIES & AWARDS**

### **Opening Ceremonies**

- There is no Opening Ceremony planned due to the tight schedule and availability of all teams being onsite at one time.

### **Provincial Awards**

- Perpetual plaques will be awarded to each team attending (1st-4th)
- Medals will be awarded to teams finishing 1st-3rd

- Championship banners, t-shirts will be awarded to those who place 1st

- No secondary Live Streaming is allowed or permitted at this event. Failure to comply may lead to disciplinary action from ASAA and hosts

## GRIEVANCE & DISCIPLINE

- A small 3-person Grievance Committee will exist in the event a team wishes to file a grievance. It will consist of:
  - ATHF President: TBD
  - Head Official at the event from ATHF: Teodora Bosonea
  - ASAA Representative: Dave Saengsathit
- There are two key focuses of the Grievance/Discipline Committee at ASAA provincials.
  - The first focus is to deal with matters that occur during competition, typically discipline/conduct issues, and appeals that may arise from ejections.
  - The second focus is to handle any other matters that arise that require dispute resolution.

## SPORTSMANSHIP

- Sportsmanship Committee: TBD
- One sportsmanship banner will be given to one team at the ASAA Provincial Championship. The team receiving this award will represent the true spirit of sportsmanship, integrity, ethics and fair play
  - Teams will vote for one team and the ASAA Commissioner will collect teams' votes on Saturday before the end of the competition. The final decision is at the discretion of the ASAA rep, Committee Chair and ASAA Handball Commissioner.
- At the end of each match, Provincial officials will choose a recipient of a ASAA sportsmanship keychain
- For Individual Sportsmanship pin awards, throughout the facilities, there will be a QR code that is available for spectators to scan, to nominate anyone that has demonstrated key aspects of sportsmanship throughout the event. These nominations will be regularly reviewed by the committee throughout the event, and keychains will be distributed to celebrate certain individuals

## SPECTATOR INFORMATION

### **ASAA Code of Conduct**

Spectators, both student and adult, must demonstrate courtesy and good sportsmanship by positive cheers of encouragement for their team, not against the opposing team. This is evidenced by the absence of booing and vulgarities. Spectators must also show proper acceptance of officials' judgment.

Artificial noisemakers are not permitted during provincial championship tournaments/events. These noisemakers may include but are not limited to: air horns, cowbells, plastic tube horns, garbage can lids, etc. The provincial championship host shall have the authority to eject from the competition facility individuals who, following a warning, refuse to comply with this requirement.

The Executive Committee or its host/designated representative shall have the authority to direct any person to immediately leave any premises or venue hosting any ASAA-sanctioned event if that person:

1. Exhibits rude or abusive
2. Uses vulgar, obscene or abusive language and/or gestures;
3. Fails to promptly follow any reasonable direction given to that person by the designated representative of the ASAA
