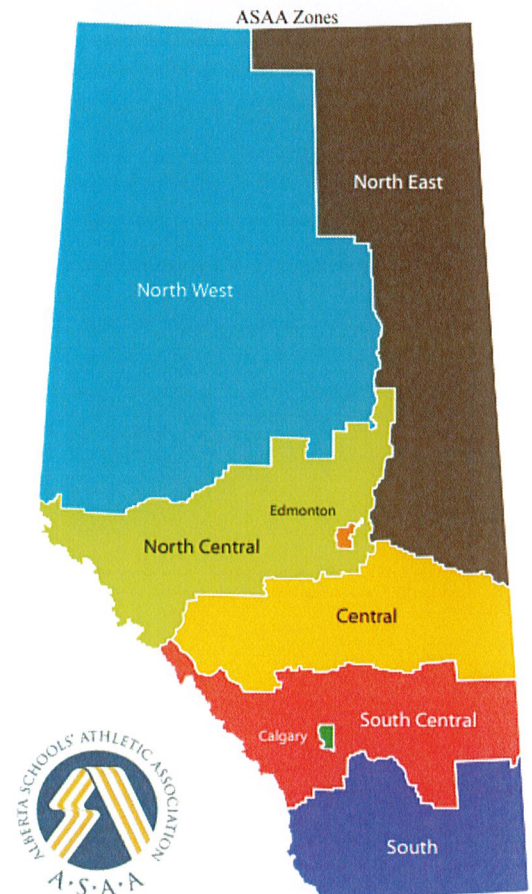

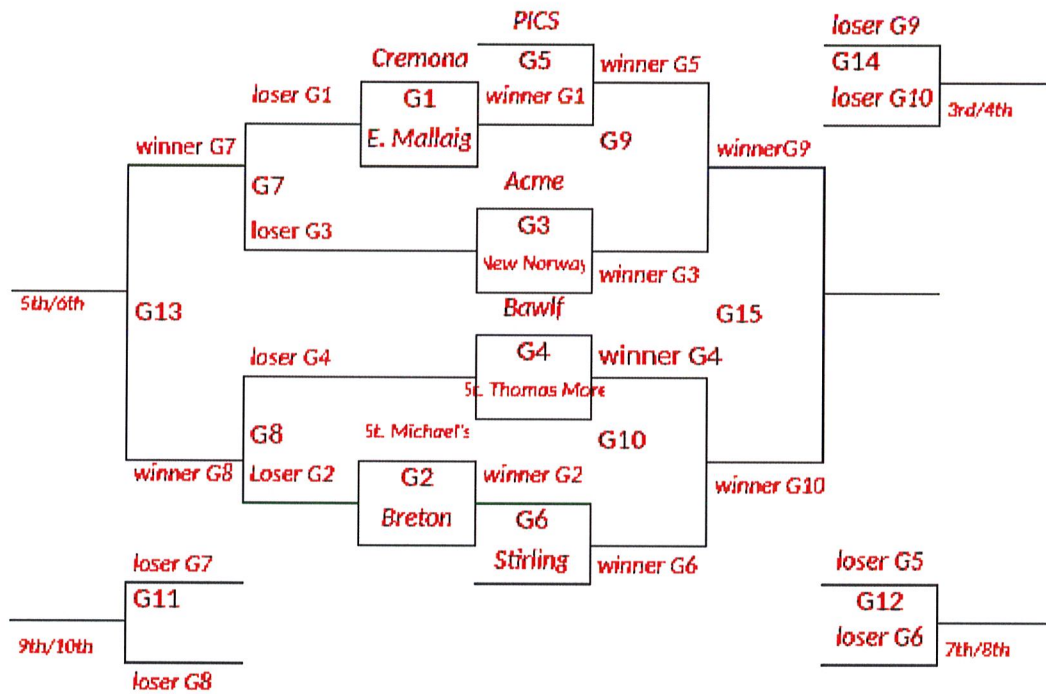


South Zone
